- What to wear during Eliminations Round:
  - Students: Proper attire (e.g., School / PE Uniform or pants/long skirts & sleeved shirts. Shorts and slippers are not allowed.)
  - o Coach / Accompanying Persons: School Uniform or business casual
- As it is the summer season, please expect hot weather during the examinations and in the exhibits / waiting areas. Air conditioning maybe limited in the testing sites, Teams are thus advised to bring portable fans and drinking water.
- All participants are to arrange their own transportation to and from the testing sites. Additional guidance and instructions for each testing site will be sent in due time.

## **ONSITE REGISTRATION FOR THE ELIMINATIONS ROUND**

- Upon arrival at the testing site gate, please present to the guard the Approved Registration Email for the school team.
- There will be an onsite registration at the testing sites on April 3, 2025. Registration will be at 10:00 -11:00 AM. Late comers may not be entertained.
- Please note that you can only register at your approved testing site. Teams that are not in the masterlist of the testing site will not be entertained.

### **ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Lunch will NOT be provided for the participants. Participants are advised to bring their own food. Please note that although there is a school / PNRI cafeteria, capacity maybe limited.
- Light snacks and water will be provided to the students during examination.
- Only items authorized by the Scientific Committee will be allowed in the examination rooms. Bags and other personal belongings of students must be left with the school coaches and/or accompanying persons during the exams.
- Companions and coaches will stay at the exhibit and/or holding area/s during the examinations.
- There will be no Wi-Fi connections at the testing sites. Guests are advised to have their own arrangements for this.
- Please observe the following basic rules for guests/visitors at the testing sites:
  - Wear Identification Cards at all times.
  - Observe cleanliness and orderliness.
  - No loitering around the premises.
