PNRI Administrative Order No. <u>01</u> Series of 2019

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6(a) of the Code of PNRI Regulations (CPRs): APPLICATION FOR NEW LICENSE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSE

WHEREAS, the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute hereinafter referred to as PNRI is mandated by Republic Act No. 2067: "Science Act of 1958", as amended, and Republic Act No. 5207: "Atomic Energy Regulatory and Liability Act of 1968", as amended, to establish and issue regulations and orders with respect to atomic energy facilities and materials for the protection of the health and safety of the workers and of the general public; and for this purpose the regulations are codified in the Code of PNRI Regulations (CPR);

WHEREAS, Part II, Section 4(m) of R.A. No. 5207 provides for the issuance, amendment and revocation of regulations and orders as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes and provisions of the Act;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) submitted the Rationalization Plan (RP) to the Department of Budget and Management in pursuant to Executive Order No. 366 dated 04 October 2004;

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management informed the PNRI through the Office of Undersecretary of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) dated March 29, 2010 the approval of the Rationalization Plan (RP);

WHEREAS, Section 7.3 of Part II under Section 7. Organizational Modifications of the Rationalization Plan, the Nuclear Regulations, Licensing and Safeguards Division (NRLSD) was changed to Nuclear Regulatory Division (NRD);

WHEREAS, the requirements on filing of license application for new or renewal of license for compliance by all holders of a PNRI license are provided in Section 6(a) of CPRs Part 11, "Licenses for Industrial Radiography and Radiation Safety Requirements for Radiographic Operations"; Part 12, "Licenses for Medical Use of Sealed Radioactive Sources in Teletherapy"; Part 14, "Licenses for Medical Use of Radioactive Sources in Brachytherapy"; Part 15, "Licenses for Large Irradiators"; CPR Part 17, "Licenses for Commercial Sale and Distribution of Radioactive Materials and its Associated Devices"; and CPR Part 20, "Licenses to Manufacture and Dispense Radiopharmaceuticals";

WHEREAS, the PNRI recognizes the need to amend the corresponding provisions on the filing of license application for new or renewal of license to address the issue that the current application forms being used are still under the former name of the division *i.e.* NRLSD;

WHEREAS, in view of this issuance, the above provisions on the specific condition on the filing of license application for new or renewal of license of the CPRs are hereby superseded;

WHEREFORE, pursuant to Part II, Section 4 (m) of R.A. No. 5207, as amended, the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute hereby issues the following amendments to the aforementioned Sections of the CPRs:

Section 1. Amendment on the Application Form.

The following amendments on the Application Form for new or renewal of license as provided in Section 6(a) of Code of PNRI Regulations (CPR) Part 11, 12, 14, 15, 17 and 20 are hereby issued. The Application Form shall be renamed as follows:

a) CPR Part 11, Licenses for Industrial Radiography and Radiation Safety Requirements for Radiographic Operations;

An application for a new or renewal of license pursuant to this Part shall be filed on PNRI/NRD Form–011, "Application for License for Industrial Radiography and Requirements for Radiographic Operations".

b) CPR Part 12, Licenses for Medical Use of Sealed Radioactive Sources in Teletherapy;

An application for a new or renewal of license pursuant to this Part shall be filed on PNRI/NRD Form-012, "Application for a License for the Medical Use of Radioactive Sources in Teletherapy", in duplicate copies.

c) CPR Part 14, Licenses for Medical Use of Radioactive Sources in Brachytherapy;

The applicant shall file an application for a new license or renewal of license pursuant to this Part on PNRI/NRD Form-014, "Application for a License for the Medical Use of Radioactive Sources in Brachytherapy", in duplicate copies.

d) CPR Part 15, Licenses for Large Irradiators;

The applicant shall file an application for a new license or renewal of license pursuant to this Part on PNRI/NRD Form-015, "Application for a License for Large Irradiators", in duplicate copies.

 e) CPR Part 17, Licenses for Commercial Sale and Distribution of Radioactive Materials and its Associated Devices;

An application for a new license or renewal of license pursuant to this Part shall be filed by completing PNRI/NRD Form-017, "Application for a License for Commercial Sale and Distribution of Radioactive Materials and Its Associated Devices", in duplicate copies.

f) CPR Part 20, Licenses to Manufacture and Dispense Radiopharmaceuticals

An application for a license pursuant to this Part shall be filed by completing PNRI/NRD Form-020, "Application for Radioactive Material License to Manufacture and Dispense Radiopharmaceuticals".

Section 2. Effectivity.

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) calendar days following its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
